# Searching the Program: Best Practices

- Search on **\*panel\* keywords** that appear in the title or abstract for the session as a whole, or on **Presenter first or last names**
  - Individual presentation titles / keywords are not available to the search function.
- To return results, the text you search must be **an exact match** to the relevant program information
  - For example, searching for “John Smith” will not pull up “John B. Smith” or visa versa
  - For this reason, shorter search queries (ie. “Smith” instead of “John Smith”) are usually more successful
